As always stay in touch with your children and their teachers, continue to check LiveGrades and have your child monitor this as well.

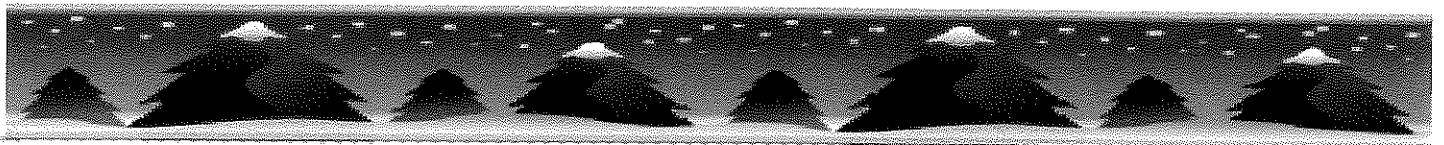

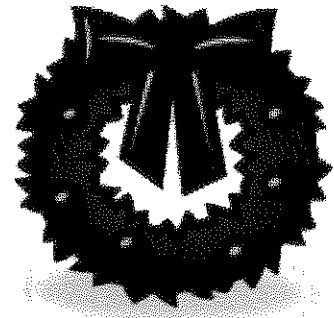


20 ESSENTIALS OF WILDWOOD MIDDLE SCHOOL

NOTES FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE

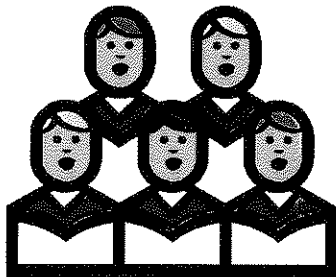
Parents of 6th graders, please be making plans to get your child's immunizations up to date for 7th grade. They will all need Tdap and MCV4 (meningitis) before they start 7th grade in August 2013.

PLEASE NOTE: Harpers Ferry Family Medicine has notified us that they will NOT fax any immunizations to us without a signed authorization from the parent requesting them to do so. You must always request that the doctor/clinic fax the documentation to the School Nurse. Our fax is 304 728-9521.

All Parents: please talk to your kids about when to come to the nurse! Many kids are coming because a baby tooth is loose or they have paper cuts. There is nothing we do for a loose baby tooth and all teachers have bandaids in their classrooms, so your child can wash a cut and put a bandaid on it and not miss class.

Encourage them to try drinking some water for a headache. Encourage them to eat breakfast! Half the headaches and stomachaches we see are cured by food. When students are out of class they are missing out on learning!

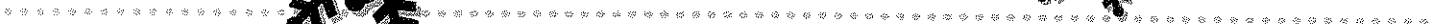
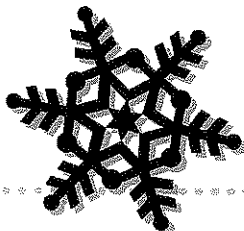


WMS Holiday Choral Program
